

**Transcript of 2818**

Ardgay  
13<sup>th</sup> March 1865

Dear Sir,

The Engineers have now placed the Centre Pin of the Sutherland Railway exactly at the lower corner of my garden, and say that the present highroad is to be shifted to between that and the corner of the house. Their first line for the Railway was in the park below the Road. I asked Mr Barclay this morning why he shifted from the old line he said he could not help doing so, I told him I would at once apply to the Proprietor – he said I might do so.

I write you in case you may think it right to come and see if matters can be remedied, as both the Railway & Road being so close will make it very [one or two words missing – corner of letter torn off].
