

Transcript of 2817.18

Scotsburn 23rd April 1864

Dear Sir,

Enclosed is a note of Posts for the Lawn. I gave the number for the West Side before, but I now give you the whole number, as I got it from Robert Ross to-day. I hope you may be able to cut them as soon as possible. Perhaps we might get some of them by next week. I have cut those for the West Side first, as the paling there is completely broken down.
