

**Transcript of 2817.37**

1868. J. Bannatyne 10<sup>th</sup> July. As to Wood for Shed at Langwell.

Langwell Lodge  
10<sup>th</sup> July 1868

Dear Sir

I have yours of the 8<sup>th</sup> and beg to thank you for your prompt reply to my request regarding the wood for the Shed for my Dog Cart, and I hope Angus McLeod has got your instructions concerning it. I saw Angus yesterday & he said he had got no instructions about it but I have no doubt he has got them now, he cannot go wrong in laying the wood down, as there is only one place where the Shed can be put up free from floods in the river, so I shall have it placed in a safe & sheltered spot.

I do trust you will soon send up the Meat Safe as at present I have no place to keep Meat in except a place off the kitchen and I can assure you the complaints from the Housekeeper are not without reason.
