I do declare that I am a Proteftant, by Trade , and to the beft of my Information and Belief, was born in the Parifh of , and County of ; that I have no Rupture, nor ever was troubled with the Fits; that I am nowife difabled by Lamanefs or otherwife, but have the perfect Ufe of my Limbs; that I have voluntarily inlifted myfelf to ferve his Majefty King GEORGE, as a Soldier in the Independent Company, commanded by Captain *William Tulloh*, and that I have received all the inlifting Money which I have agreed for, and have heard the Articles of War againft Mutiny and Defertion read to me : As Witnefs my Hand, this Day of

THESE are to certify, that of the Parifh of , and County of , aged , by Trade , Size Feet Inches, came before me, one of his Majefty's Juftices of the Peace for the County of , and declared, that he had voluntarily inlifted himfelf to ferve his Majefty King GEORGE, in the Independent Company, commanded by Captain *William Tulloh*; and he is therefore duly inlifted, and has heard read to him the Articles of War againft Mutiny and Defertion, and has taken the Oath of Fidelity mentioned in the faid Articles.
