

Transcript of 2816

Minutes of a Meeting of the Parochial Board of the Parish of Tain held 13th Augt 1847.

At Tain the thirteenth day of August Eighteen Hundred and forty seven years.

In a Meeting of the Parochial Board of the Parish of Tain held in terms of the appointment of the Meeting held on the Fifteenth July last.

Bailie Innes was chosen Chairman of the Meeting.

The Minutes of the Meeting of the 15th Ultimo were read over to the Meeting and approved of.

The letter of Captain Grant was laid on the table.

The Meeting refuse to sustain the appeal of William Arklay(?) Dundee.

The Meeting restrict the assessment of Mrs Bruce for the present year to the extent of Nine Shillings and one half penny as Tenant.

The Meeting exempt Mrs Ellison as Tenant to the Extent of Three Pounds Eleven Shillings and nine pence.

The Meeting considering that George Munro Carter is not Proprietor of the House occupied by Roderick Mackenzie appoint Robert Ross to be assessed for that House and exempted George Munro one half as Proprietor and Tenant of House occupied by him.

The Meeting restrict the assessment on the Trustees of James Mackay Cabinetmaker to the extent of Twelve Shillings and two pence half penny.

The Meeting restrict Mrs MacPherson New House's(?) assessment to the extent of Five Shillings.

The Meeting exempt Catherine Ross Vintner to the extent of Seven Shillings and six pence.

The Meeting exempt Miss Helen Ross to the extent of Three Shillings and nine pence.

The Meeting exempt Mr David Ross Perth as Proprietor.

The Meeting restrict Mrs J. B. Ross assessment to One Pound Sterling.

The Meeting restrict the assessment on Mrs Ross Vintner Little Tain to the extent of Six Shillings and eight pence farthing.

Bailie Innes having left the Chair Bailie Munro was elected Chairman.

The Meeting exempt Donald Ross Pensioner to the extent of One Shilling and seven pence half penny.

The Meeting exempt Hugh Stewart Tinsmith to the extent of Four Shillings and one penny.

The Meeting refer the exemptions claimed by parties assessed in the immediately preceding assessment to the Committee formerly appointed and they appoint the names of John MacLauren Bailie Donald Munro and Mr John MacLeod to be added to said Committee.

The Meeting order a Sum of Two Shillings and six pence and one Stone Oatmeal to be given to Janet Smart.

The Meeting appoint a Sum of Two Pounds Two Shillings to be paid Christy MacKenzie for attendance on Widow Munro Michael.

The Meeting appoint Widow Hugh Sutherland to be put on the Roll at the rate of One Shilling per week.

The Meeting exempt Alexander Ross Fendom.

The Meeting appoint a Sum of Five Shillings to be paid to Widow George Patience.
